

PHBA Entry Fee: All entry fees are per horse, per judge, each day. \$8.00 per class per judge, or \$40.00 maximum per horse, per judge, each day – no matter how many divisions you show in or how many exhibitors show the horse. (\$120.00 per day max-out per horse). Special incentive for horses age 2 and under: All class fees for horses age 2 and under will be \$5.00 per class per judge.

ABRA Entry Fee: All entry fees are per horse, per judge, each day. \$6.00 per class per judge or ABRA Youth Divisions All-Day fee \$90.00, ABRA Amateur Division All-Day fee \$90.00, ABRA Amateur Select Division All-Day fee \$50.00, ABRA Open Division All-Day fee \$75.00.

NSBA Entry Fee: Extra \$4 per class for each NSBA entry. NSBA Classes will run concurrently with the same class. One Judge per day will be judging the NSBA classes.

Open Walk/Trot payback class fee \$5.00. 50% payback.

Open Tiny Tot Walk/Trot fee \$10.00 per class.

PHBA Additional Fees: Computer administration fee and office charges: \$6.00 per horse, per judge, per day. (\$18.00 per day per horse).

ABRA Additional Fees: Computer administration fee and office charges: \$6.00 per horse, per day

Camping Fees: \$20.00 per day if plugged in, \$15.00 per day if not.

Stalls: \$54.00 for the weekend. Day stalls are \$25.00 each day if available. Jump-Out fee for non-stalled horses \$15.00 per day. The stalls will be available after 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday. You will need to pay an additional \$10.00 if coming in on Wednesday night. NO EXCEPTIONS. Shavings are available for \$7.00 per bag. Note: Stalls are cement.

Hi-Point All-Around Awards will be given for PHBA 5-9, PHBA Novice Youth, PHBA Youth 13 & Under, PHBA Youth 14-18, PHBA Novice Amateur, PHBA Amateur, PHBA Amateur Select and PHBA Open.

High-Point All-around & Reserve High-Point All-Around Awards will be given for ABRA Youth 13 & Under, ABRA Youth 14-18, ABRA Amateur, ABRA Amateur Select and ABRA Open Divisions.

ALL PHBA class entrants must provide a COPY of their PHBA card front & back) and a COPY of their horse's papers (front & back) to the show secretary. If you forget your card or do not have one you will be required to purchase a non-refundable temporary membership. Temporary membership must be purchased with a separate check made payable to PHBA.

ALL ABRA class entrants must provide a COPY of their ABRA card (front & back) and a COPY of their horse's papers (front & back) to the show secretary to keep on file. Horses must be registered with ABRA and you must also be an ABRA member in order to show ABRA approved classes. You must also have an ABRA Youth or Amateur card in order to show in ABRA Youth or Amateur classes. All horses must have an original and one copy of a current negative coggins test paper (drawn in 2012). Copy is to be left on file in the office. All out of state horses must have current interstate health papers.

NEW THIS YEAR: Everything will be done on a computer system this year so we are asking that all PHBA & ABRA exhibitors pre-register ahead of time to make it easier for the show office. You will need to send in your pre-entry form, a copy of the front and back of your horses registration papers, a copy of the front and back of your Association cards, and a copy of your 2012 coggins. If you plan on showing at both the June and August shows you will only need to send in your registration papers, association cards, and coggins for the June show, as we will keep those on file for the entire year. You will need to send in your pre-entry form separately for both shows though. You can find a pre-entry form for the PHBA classes at <http://www.wipalomino.com> and you can find a pre-entry form for the ABRA classes at <http://www.swbuckskin.com>. **Deadline for pre-entering for the June show is May 21st and the deadline for the August show is July 30th.** No payment is required with your pre-entries, only the completed entry form. You can add or cancel classes when you arrive at the show, but you do need to pre-enter at least one class so we can set you up in the computer system.

PHBA Wisconsin Members:

Year-end awards. To be eligible for year-end awards, you must show the same horse at least two of the three days, at both the June and the August shows in each category and be present at our annual meeting for each division in which you qualify. Plus you or a member of your immediate family must sell one ad for our annual promotional booklet. The booklet is printed in the spring, and the ads must be submitted by March 15th for publication in the current year's booklet. All ads must be submitted and paid in full by end of day on Saturday of the June show to qualify for that year hi-point awards. Ads submitted after March 15th will be published in the following year's booklet. Check with the show secretary for more information.

DIRECTIONS:

From the north: Take I-90 until you get to Madison, then take I-94 towards Milwaukee. Take I-94 to the Johnson Creek exits, Hwy 26. Take Hwy 26 south towards Jefferson. In Jefferson continue to Hwy N, turn right and continue over a bridge and for another couple of blocks to the stop sign. Fairgrounds will be straight ahead, entrance is 1 block to your right.

From the south: Take I-90 towards Janesville. At Janesville take Hwy 26 north towards Fort Atkinson and Jefferson area. Go past Fort Atkinson on the bypass (stay on 26) to Jefferson. In Jefferson, when you get to the stop lights turn left onto Hwy 18 W. Continue on Hwy 18 over a bridge and an additional 4 blocks, turn right onto Jackson Street. Go a couple blocks and the fairgrounds will be on your left.

From Highways 151, 18 14 and 12(west & south beltline) in Madison: Stay on Hwy 12/18 South through Madison and continue towards Cambridge and Jefferson area. Follow Hwy 18 when it turns off to the left, (stay on 18). As you come into Jefferson, turn left onto Jackson St. Go a couple of blocks and the fairgrounds will be on your left.
